April 2016 RRRC Meeting Minutes

The regular monthly meeting of the Rock River Radio Club was called to order on Tuesday, April 5, 2015, by RRRC President Ryan Klavekoske, KB9OWD, at 7:03 PM.

** Committee Reports **

Treasurer's Report: The Treasurer's report for May, 2015, was presented by RRRC Treasurer Judy Mullen, KB9MKK. All financial transactions for January were presented and reviewed by the group. There were no financial activities in February or March. There were no additions or corrections from the group. A motion to accept the Treasurer's Report as presented was made by Ralph Hasler, N9WBL, with second by Jerry Arndt, NO9U. A vote was taken and the motion passed.

Secretary's Report: Due to the two cancelled meetings in February and March, RRRC Secretary Dennis Weigel, KC9ICA, presented the minutes from the January meeting as they were published in the February newsletter. There were no additions or corrections. A motion to accept the minutes as published was made by Ralph Hasler, N9WBL, and seconded by Gary Pedersen, KA9BAE. A vote was taken and the motion was passed.

Trailer Committee: Dave DePover, K9MKP, reported that he had nothing new to report.
Repeater Committee: Dale Marks, WB9ADB, brought copies of the Wisconsin Association of Repeaters March Newsletter and Repeater Listing. They were circulated for everyone to see. The WAR Chairmen and Vice-Chairmen had resigned last fall and replacements have been re-elected for both offices. We had one incident of interference on our W9TCH repeater which was isolated to someone's radio. We will be monitoring for other interference in the future if it happens.

Watertown ARC News: Jerry Arndt, NO9U, reported that the re-organization of the Watertown Radio Club is going very well. The Club has all new officers in place and programs lined up to the end of the year. They have added some new members and their Tuesday night Net is active and growing, as well.

Dale, WB9ADB, agreed to provide this as part of his report at the next Club meeting.

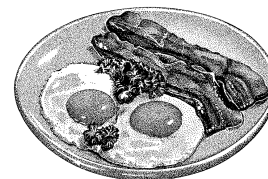
