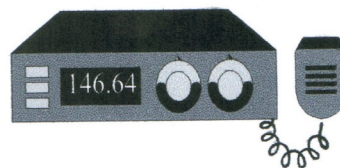

** Committee Reports **

Treasurer's Report: The Treasurer's report for April, 2016, was unavailable due to the absence of RRRC Treasurer Judy Mullen, KB9MKK. The April report will be presented with the May report at the June meeting.

Secretary's Report: RRRC Secretary presented the minutes for the April meeting as they were published in the May Newsletter. There were no additions or corrections. 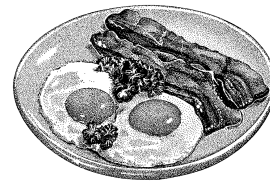
