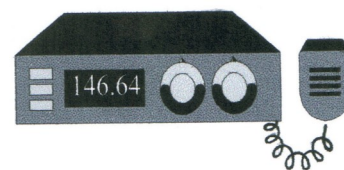

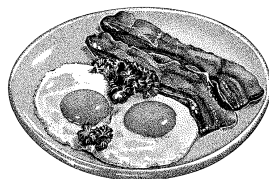

February 2018 RRRRC Meeting Minutes

The regular monthly meeting of the Rock River Radio Club was called to order on Tuesday, February 6, 2018, by RRRRC Vice President Dave DePover, K9MKP, at 7:13 PM.

**** Committee Reports ****

Treasurer's Report: The Treasurer's report covering December 2017 and January 2018 was presented by RRRRC Secretary Dennis Weigel, KC9ICA. Financial transactions were presented to the group. There were no additions or corrections. A motion to accept the Treasurer's Report as presented was made by Ralph Hasler, N9WBL, and seconded by Jerry Arndt, NO9U. A vote was taken and the motion passed.

Secretary's Report: The minutes for the December 2017 meeting were presented by RRRRC Secretary Dennis Weigel, KC9ICA, as they were published in the January 2018 Newsletter. There were no additions or corrections. A motion to accept the minutes as presented was made by Ralph Hasler, N9WBL, and seconded by Jerry Arndt, NO9U. A vote was taken and the motion passed. There was no meeting in January due to bad weather, and therefore no January minutes were available.

Repeater Committee: Dale Marks, WB9ADB, reported that there was nothing new with the W9TCH repeater over the last month.

Field Day Committee: Dale, WB9ADB, reported that 3 of the reserved campsites are still available, one of which will be used for the Club trailer. Of the 2 left, Nyles Priest, W9KUW, said he wished to take site #16.

A.R.E.S.: Dals Marks, WB9ADB, and Dennis Weigel, KC9ICA, attended the SIMCOMM conference in Madison. Dennis reported that the morning sessions that they attended covered

message and emergency traffic handling procedures. This included becoming familiar with the proper forms used with the various served agencies. Time was also spent on actual practice in formatting, sending, and receiving messages. The afternoon sessions covered what to expect during winter weather operating and preparedness for protection from the cold as well as how to tell when others are becoming affected even when they have not notice it themselves. The training was very well done and the day was very informative and worthwhile.

**** Old Business ****

Emergency Communication Trailer: A short discussion was held regarding items that need to be completed on the trailer. The items included installation of the LP furnace, stabilizing jacks, and refrigerator that we already have available. These will be warm-weather projects where groups can get together to get them done.

**** New Business ****

Weather Spotter Training: Dale Marks, WB9ADB, said that the weather spotter training program will be held in Mayville in April this year. He did not have details yet, but he will pass them along when he does.

The monthly RRRRC breakfast will be held as usual at the Village Garden Restaurant in Juneau on Saturday, February 10th, at 8:00 AM.
