PRESIDENT'S REPORT

On Monday, April 23, several of our members attended the annual National Weather Service severe weather spotter training held this year in Mayville. This two hour training provides up to date information for individuals interested in severe weather spotting and reporting. Within the program, they have allotted time for us to explain our role in weather spotting and reporting to the National Weather Service. There is valuable information for new and seasoned spotters within the program. I was unable to attend due to a work commitment and look forward to hearing how the training went and what new information may have been provided at the May meeting.

The weather training led to the cancellation of our Monday net on April 23 and I hope Dennis' message made it to everyone. Dennis attended the training and I was out of town for work so we did not have a net control station. With several others reported to be attending the training event, we decided to cancel the net for the evening.

At our May meeting, we will circulate a sign-up sheet for the first brat fry on Saturday, June 2. We have set three hour shifts in the past from 9:00 A.M. to noon and the afternoon shift from noon to 3:00 P.M. The 11:30 to 1:00 time frame are generally our busiest time and it's important to be well staffed and cooked ahead

during this time. If you have the chance, please join us and lend a hand at the event. If you can't make it to the meeting but would like to help out, please send an e-mail to myself or Dennis, KC9ICA.



Save These Dates


