

kv4p HT

Turn your Android phone into a modern ham radio transceiver Free open source software & hardware



What is it?

kv4p HT is a homebrew VHF radio that makes your phone capable of voice and text communication completely off-grid with at least a Technician class amateur radio license.

The radio simply plugs into the USB C port on your Android smartphone and transforms it into a fully-fledged handheld radio transceiver. It's completely open source (GPL3): the Android app, ESP32 firmware, PCB designs, and 3D printer files.

It's small enough to fit in your pocket and take anywhere, and since it has no internal battery it's the perfect radio to put in a go-bag or your car's glove compartment.

NOTE: kv4p HT is an open source project you build yourself and has absolutely no warranty, or guarantees on functionality or reliability! That said, have fun. :)

- 100% ham radio, always completely off-grid
- Crystal-clear 44kHz 8-bit ADC/DAC audio, with filters and squelch
- Texting with notifications just like SMS radio-based APRS messaging (not just location) with built-in 1200 baud modem

- 1 watt transmit can go miles yet sips your phone's battery



Barry Goldwater, N7UGA, was a US Senator for Arizona from 1969-1987. He also was an active ham radio operator.

During his time in Congress, Senator Goldwater supported the right to vote for people 18 years or older, repealed the Military Selective Service Act, and was responsible for the "Goldwater Amateur Radio" legislation that established the VEC program, the Amateur Auxiliary, and exempted Ham Radio from the secrecy provisions in the Communications Act of 1934. This important legislation also permitted the FCC to set RFI susceptibility standards for home electronic equipment.

Barry was the President of QCWA in 1972-1973. He was a Life Member of ARRL, and Life Member of the Central Arizona DX Association. While living in Washington D.C., Barry maintained the call sign K3UIG. Barry received his first Amateur radio license in 1922 with the call 6BPI.



The Central Arizona DX Association participated as Special Event Operation K7UGA in the 2024 Arizona QSO Party on Saturday, October 12, 2024, from member Brian W7JET and Eve W7EVE's QTH.

I was also invited to be part of the special event stations operators.

We had a blast and made 670 QSOs, thanks to Brian's awesome station and antenna farm.



KNOWLES REPEATER WIRES-X NODE UPDATE

The WIRES-X Node in Mayville is up and operational! If you have a Yaesu WIRES-X rig or HT and are outside of the Knowles Repeater coverage area, you can "remote" into the repeater on C4FM digital mode.

NOTE: your audio will come across only on C4FM, not analog FM. Your audio, however, will be crystal clear. Our repeater does not have Internet access, but the WIRES-X Node in Mayville makes this possible.

While in Mesa AZ I was mobile and talking with Dale WB9ADB via the Usery Mountain WIRES-X repeater. My audio went from that repeater to the Mayville Node via the internet. Then via C4FM RF to the Knowles Repeater. Audio was extremely clear. The distance between our locations even shows up on the screen of our rigs (1,403 miles). How cool is that?
