

What is a Geochron? Here is part of an article from our January 2024 newsletter:

Have you heard of a Geochron? Read on to learn more about this amazing ham shack addition!



Geochron started making very cool wall mounted mechanical clocks in 1962. The company was originally located in Redwood City, California and at that time Patrick was a young lad living about 5 miles away. They have had several different owners and have relocated a few times over the years. To this day, they still offer handmade, beautiful wall mounted clocks and restore old ones. Each new mechanical clock takes 25 hours to assemble.

In 2015, Patrick Bolan (KJ7ZSU) bought the company. In 2018, Geochron came out with a digital version. It was a very small computer and had an HDMI 4k output so it can be used with any 4k display or TV. The current digital model is called the Atlas 4k Version 2. The

digital model gets its data from the Internet, so the possibilities are endless. It has upgradable firmware that is regularly updated with new features. The Atlas 4k simply plugs into your 4k TV. And these days, huge 4K TVs are pretty cheap! The Geochron Atlas 4k is available directly from Geochron, Ham Radio Outlet and DX Engineering.

With some help from the internet, we were able to construct one. The Arduino itself is similar to a Raspberry Pi in some respects. It's basically a tiny computer. With some creative soldering and programming, we were able to send out a tone and Cameron's call sign via Morse Code.

We did learn some on the Fox Hunt and plan to shorten the time between transmissions and get a bigger battery for it. Although, three hours of run time was pretty good, we can always do better. If we decrease the time between transmission, the battery will go out sooner.

### NEW Winlink Vara FM / Packet Winlink Gateway

<u>What the heck is Winlink?</u> Winlink, also known as Winlink Global Radio Email, is a worldwide radio messaging system. It uses amateur radio frequencies to provide various services, including:

**Email with attachments** 

Position reporting

Weather bulletins

Emergency and relief communications

Message relay

This system is particularly valuable in situations where the internet is unavailable, such as remote locations or during emergencies

What the heck is a Winlink Gateway? A Winlink gateway is a station that connects amateur radio operators to the internet, allowing them to send and receive emails over radio frequencies. These gateways are crucial in emergencies when traditional local cell phone and internet connections might be unavailable.

Winlink gateways can operate on various frequencies, including HF, VHF, and UHF. They use specialized software and hardware to facilitate this communication, ensuring that critical information can be transferred even over long distances.

We are happy to announce we are testing a new Winlink Gateway at KA9JDE's QTH, 10 miles north of Ripon. The call is KA9JDE-10 and operates on 145.61 MHz. It took quite a bit of effort to get this up and running. A BIG thank you to Len KB9GDY, Dale WB9ADB, Kevin KC9YPK and Brad KA9JDE that helped make this a possibility. All at no cost to the RRRC.




The RRRC's mobile tower setup


New Winlink Gateway Features:

- If cell service and/or the Internet are not available in Dodge County (due to a tornado, etc.), these services may still be available north of Ripon.
- □ 20kw automatic whole house backup generator.
- ☐ Gateway is 24/7
- □ Once you learn how to use the WinLink software, you can send email or texts to the Winlink Gateway via radio.
- ☐ Messages can be sent via Vara FM or via Packet Winlink.
- Good coverage. Dale, WB9ADB, our Dodge County Emergency Coordinator, is able to access the new Gateway. That is via 2 meter simplex at a distance of about 35 miles using Dale's omni-directional Discone antenna.
- ☐ The gateway uses a Diamond CP22E 9' fiberglass antenna at about 40'.

Other current Winlink Gateways in Dodge County are KC9YPK-10 in Mayville and KB9GDY-10 in Randolph.
