After our last meeting, I want to say how pleased I am that we could come together and make some great decisions on our new trailer. I cannot wait to see it. This is a great




opportunity for us to come together as a club and see its full potential realized. At our next meeting I believe we'll begin voting on interior items so come with ideas and plans for the club to review.

What is a Fox Hunt?

A Fox Hunt is an amateur radio event where participants use radio direction-finding techniques to locate a hidden transmitter—known as "The Fox." **You do not need to be a ham radio operator to participate!**

This fall's foxes: Peter AD9DO and Cameron KD9GV (our Spring Fox Hunt winners).

Why Do We Hunt the Fox?

Fox Hunts are fun activities, but they also prepare operators for real-world situations where direction-finding is essential:

- Tracking interference sources (2005 hams helped identify and eliminate sources of interference on critical frequencies after hurricane Katrina)
- Ø Finding lost or injured people (Stanislaus National Forest, CA July 11, 2025 a mom and her 9-year-old were overdue from a Sierra trip. Ham radio played a key role in locating them; coordination over ham frequencies helped SAR (Search And Rescue) narrow the search and make contact).
- **E** Locating downed aircraft (assisting Civil Air Patrol and local authorities)

A "hamfest" is a gathering, often a weekend event, for amateur radio operators (or "hams") to socialize, buy, sell, and trade amateur radio equipment, participate in forums and seminars, and potentially take amateur radio license exams.

Here's a more detailed breakdown:

Social Event:

Hamfests are primarily social events where hams can connect with each other and share their passion for amateur radio.

Flea Market:

A significant part of a hamfest is a flea market where attendees can buy, sell, and trade a wide variety of amateur radio equipment, from vintage to modern, and related accessories.

Seminars and Forums:

Many hamfests feature seminars and forums covering various aspects of amateur radio, including technical, operational, and legal topics.

License Exams:

Some hamfests also host volunteer examiner teams (VEs) who administer amateur radio license exams.

Commercial Exhibits:

Some hamfests include commercial exhibits where manufacturers and vendors showcase and sell their

amateur radio equipment.

Amateur Radio Clubs:

Hamfests can also serve as a venue for meetings of

amateur radio clubs.
