


SUMMITS ON THE AIR (SOTA) PARKS ON THE AIR (POTA) WISCONSIN WINTER FUN!

As mentioned at our last RRRC meeting, I planned to do a SOTA / POTA road trip the next day, Wednesday, January 8th. Since my passion is SOTA, I chose Wausau as my destination because Rib Mountain is a SOTA summit, and since it is a state park, it is also a POTA site. That makes it a "two-fer". Rib Mountain is 6 point SOTA summit and a "drive up", which means any of you could do it! The last time Rib Mountain was SOTA activated was September 18, 2024. Do you think that might be because it is REALLY COLD during winter in Wisconsin? Fortunately for me, Rib Mountain has a 3 point SOTA Winter Bonus from December 1 to March 31. I really earned the winter bonus as it was 12 degrees out. I made 20 SSB contacts.



No using a vehicle to keep warm with SOTA!



Next stop, Mosinee Hill, which is also a "drive up" SOTA summit. I will be making up for that over the next 3 weeks while backpacking up to many of the summits I activate in Arizona! Even at a drive up SOTA summit, the rules require you carry all you gear to where you set up your portable station. You are not allowed to use your vehicle even for support for your antenna mast. The activation was a success with 6 SSB contacts. SOTA requires a minimum 4 contacts whereas POTA requires 10. One contact was to a SOTA Chaser in France.


